## CHRISTMAS OPENING HOURS

Do take care in the icy conditions and always wear headgear with bikes, rollerblades and other active xmas presents. If a dental accident occurs do contact the practice immediately, swift action makes a big difference. If an adult tooth is knocked out the following steps are recommended:

- Handle the tooth avoiding touching the root
- Remove any debris by gentle rinsing the tooth with water or milk
- Place the tooth by hand back into the socket, if possible or store in milk or saliva
- The child should see a dentist for treatment as soon as possible.
